### Father Tom writes :-

---

#### First Reading: *Isaiah: 42: 1-4, 6-7*

The assurances which God gives to the Messiah of his presence with him in all he did in accordance to God's Will is to be of great encouragement to him who is to be called Messiah. God owns that the Messiah did not take the honour of being Mediator to himself, but was called by God, that he was no intruder, no usurper, but was in himself the Truth.

#### Second Reading: *Acts 10: 34-38*

Peter preaches to Cornelius and his friends because they were Gentiles and they were interested in the gospel of Christ, which he had to

preach. He proclaims their entitlement to the benefits of the Gospel of Christ upon an equal footing with the Jews. It was necessary that this should be made clear to them, so that he can assure them that what he preaches they can hear and take to their benefit.

#### Gospel: *Luke 3: 15-16. 21-22*

We are now drawing near to the appearance of our Lord Jesus publicly. We are told the Sun will not be long after the morning-star. John confirmed them in their expectations of the Messiah, and that his office, as a crier or herald, was to give notice that the kingdom of God and the King of that kingdom were at hand. Therefore, when he had told the people what they must do he tells them one thing more which they must all do; they must expect the Messiah now shortly to appear.

#### Collect

Eternal Father,  
who at the baptism of Jesus  
revealed him to be your Son,  
anointing him with the Holy Spirit:  
grant to us, who are born again by water and the Spirit,  
that we may be faithful to our calling as your adopted children;  
through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord,  
who is alive and reigns with you,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever.
